# From the Archives...

## The WOA Newsletter of April 1999

### **FEATURES**

Andrew Thompson's second cover page as editor featured Homer Simpson eagerly inspecting a letterbox, presumably for "Tales of WOA".

At Katoa Po, the night relays, OHV was awarded the "Best Headgear" prize. But in spite a PA system it was outgunned by HBOC for "Best Club Spirit". They had Richard Lynn's stentorian roar instead. The event (and an OY next day) was held on the Taurewa map near Turangi. First team across the line was from Taranaki, with Karl Dravitzki running very well to stay ahead of Brent Edwards who had the advantage of a light to follow. However the win was awarded to Edwards' WACO team, because anyone running the first two legs (designed for kids) under 15min is handicapped up to 15min.

Ten years earlier, the all-junior "bRATPAK ATTACK" won the relay in a sprint finish. Phil Wood made up 6 minutes on Jim Lewis in the last leg to win by 10 seconds. The other team members in 1989 were Tim Haines, Antonia Wood, Stephen Leary, Julien Donaldson, Mark Mclean and Peter Hill. Fast-forward to 2009: Ratpak and WACO are no more, Taranaki was grooving to WOMAD, and Hawkes Bay took the 7-person win, as well as the first FOUR places in the 5-person category!

RK reminded readers about a score event at Scotts Ferry on 25 April. "It will be signposted from SH50 near Tikokino." This was probably a mistake. Clearly the date should have been 1 April.

Newlands College orienteers raised \$1500 for travel to the Silva SS Champs near Dunedin, by holding a garage sale. All 22 team members were involved.

Vet runners Gillian Ingham and Sue Lyttle, finishing a minute apart, both ran under the OPEN womens record for the Tararua Mountain Race. Lyttle (secretary of Wairarapa OC) already held the vet womens record, and Ingham was to hold it for four years. However Antonia Wood was faster still, taking 50 minutes off to establish an open womens record of 5hr35 that (technically) still stands today. Technically because in 2006 veteran woman Carline Thomas ran 4sec quicker!

This year's race was won by Wellington orienteer Jamie Stewart. Former HV orienteer Grant Maud was the fastest individual vet, and another Allan Stowell was in the winning mixed team. The race follows the "Southern Crossing" from Kaitoke to Otaki Forks.

### **RESULTS**

Steve Holden did just enough to win the 1999 O-Max Series and retain the title he won a year earlier. In a heat containing two National and one Development Squad member, he cruised home in fifth place, but close enough to the pace to clear Alan Horn by 34sec over the series, and a limping Chris Holden by just under a minute.

OY1 was run by Kapiti HAVOC at Queen Elizabeth Park. Malcolm Ingham WN headed off Mark Hudson HB in M21A by 6min, Penny Kane WN beat Katie Hill WN by 35sec. There were 186 participants, perhaps helped by being a CSW series event as well. The second OY was to be at The Slump in Hawkes Bay, but reluctance to travel later put a stop to events this far away.

The Safari is a hit with adventure racers, who can see races round the world being brought into cities for promotional reasons. And yet Wellington has rugged terrain within a stone's throw of the beehive! It's a hit with families, who can tailor a day out to their needs, using buses to rest tired little legs. And it's a hit with public transport operators, after overwhelmingly positive media coverage. Numbers have ballooned each year and it could become NZ's largest rogaine.

The checkpoints will be spread around Wellington again, with redrawn boundaries and further refinement of the unique "super-topo" map showing bus-stops, tracks, parks and shortcuts. Checkpoints could be anywhere from the Massey Memorial at Miramar to the quarry at Owhiro Bay to the top of Mt Kaukau! The flat downtown area with businesses, waterfront and other parks; the hilly suburbs with their bushclad gullies, threaded by the town belt and walkways; and peaks such as Kaukau and Makara with their spectacular outlooks. The public transport network goes right through the area, much of it on a 15-minute frequency. Yep, even on Sunday!

The winning team will require fitness and speed, but the way they use the buses and trains will also be vital. A travel pass is part of the entry!
